Adelaide University Sport and Fitness (AUSF) Scholarship Terms and Conditions 2023

Details of Participation

Information on how to enter forms part of these Details of Participation and entry is deemed as acceptance of them.

Applications are now open for 2024 and close at 12pm Friday 8 March 2024 for all scholarships.

Applications not received by that date or not completed in accordance with the Details of Participation will not be eligible for shortlisting.

The Applicant Must:

- be a University of Adelaide student currently actively studying (as of census date on 21 March 2024)
- be an active financial member of an Adelaide University Sport and Fitness Club including the Elite Athlete Club
- make a considerable contribution to their chosen Adelaide University Sport and Fitness Club

NB* scholarships will not be awarded to individuals who are not members of an AU club when a suitable one exists.

How to apply

Applications will not be considered unless an application is completed in full and all supporting documentation are received by AUSF before the closing date, 8 March 2024. This is the sole responsibility of the applicant.

Specific Club Scholarships will be nominated by the club directly to AUSF. The Club will be required to nominate multiple students with a recommendation for the Blues Committee to consider.

Selection Process

The Blues Committee of Adelaide University Sport and Fitness meets every year to rank scholarship applicants.

While each Scholarship will have its own weighted criteria, overall Scholarships will be determined in accordance with the following categories:

- Competition and Performance at a High Level of Sport e.g. International and national Selections, Performances & Results, National Level Selections, Performances & Results.
- Competition in which the candidate provides enthusiasm and encouragement to other club members
- A scholarship may not be awarded in the event there is not a suitable application received.

Notification

Applicants will be informed of the outcome by email.

Requirements for scholarship recipients

The Award of the scholarship will depend upon the recipient agreeing to the following:

- Abide by usual University of Adelaide regulations.
- Comply with AUSF policies and those of the Adelaide University Club the recipient is a member of.
- Maintain a high standard of conduct and bearing at all times when representing AUSF.
- Provide updates in writing midyear/end of year or after a major competition indicating details of sporting activity to AUSF.
- Remain a student at the University during the scholarship period.

- Attend the AUSF Blues Awards Function.
- Complete 8 hours of voluntary work with AUSF by 31 December in the year the scholarship was awarded.

In addition, the following scholarship specific requirements apply for scholarship recipients:

The AU Presidents Scholarship – 3 x Scholarships available

\$2,000 IN YEAR 1 & Club fees covered in year 1, 2 & 3

In addition to the requirements outlined in the General Terms and Conditions, applicants for the Sport President's Scholarship must be a first-year University of Adelaide student proceeding towards a degree or diploma and become a member of the selected AU Sport Club upon receiving the Scholarship and make a considerable contribution to their chosen AUSport Club upon receiving the Scholarship. Up to three Scholarships can be offered per year.

The Don Stranks Scholarship – AU Football Club & AU Cricket Club

\$2,000 Scholarship Awarded

Criteria

- In addition to the requirements outlined in the General Terms and Conditions, applicants for the Don Strank's Scholarship must be an athlete and financial member with the AU Cricket Club or AU Football club.
- Must also be a member of a team playing in the Division 1/Premier Division and/ or premier grade cricket competition.
- One Scholarship is available for the AU Football Club OR for the AU Cricket Club.

The AU Soccer Club Scholarships –

\$2,000 per Scholarship Awarded

Criteria

- In addition to the requirements outlined in the General Terms and Conditions, applicants for the AUS Soccer Club Scholarship must be an athlete and financial member with the AU Soccer Club.
- Must also be a member of a team playing in the Division 1/Premier Division (State League 1) competition.
- 1 Men's & 1 Women's Scholarship will be offered each year as long as the eligibility criteria is met.

The Charlie Jessop Sport Scholarship

\$2,000 per Scholarship Awarded

Criteria

- In addition to the requirements outlined in the General Terms and Conditions, applicants for the Charlie Jessop Sport Scholarship must be a University of Adelaide student within the ABLE (Arts, Business, Law, Economics) faculty
- The Scholarship is for a student athlete who excels at their sport and also provides valuable service to their AU Sporting Club.

The Bob Heddle Sport Scholarship – 1X Scholarship available

\$3,000 Scholarship Awarded

Criteria

- In addition to the requirements outlined in the General Terms and Conditions, applicants for the Bob Heddle Scholarship must be an active & financial member of an AU Sports Club. This includes the Elite Athlete Club. If awarded to a Club Coach, the Coach must have been a Coach for at least three years.
- 1X Scholarship will be awarded based on
 - 100% weight to their sporting performance. This is looking to highlight exceptional International Performance & Result

The People's Choice Credit Union Scholarship Terms and Conditions

In addition to the requirements outlined in the General Terms and Conditions, applicants for the People's Choice Credit Union (PPCU) Scholarship must comply with the following requirements:

- The scholarship recipient cannot be linked to any other financial institution
- Scholarship funds of \$1,000 will be deposited into a People's Choice Credit Union account to be accessed by the recipient along with a PPCU shirt to be worn for images to be used for PPCU promotional purposes
- The scholarship recipient will be asked to participate in a branch activity e.g. scholarship winners meet and greet, update People's Choice Credit Union on how they are going, quarterly update with PPCU.
- A student profile including images will be requested for social media and newsletter purposes which the recipient will also post to their own social channels with relevant hashtags.
- Scholarship recipient will be asked to complete an end of year review on how they have used the funds, results etc

Applications for these scholarships will be reviewed by the People's Choice Credit Union Scholarship judging committee.
