



AUSF Travelling Team COVID-19 Agreement

Due to the unpredictable nature of COVID-19, it is important all participants carefully consider associated risks relating to their travel to and participation in UniSport Nationals. UniSport Australia and AUSF continues to follow government-issued health advice, and adheres to the current state/territory directions in which the event is being held. Participants must ensure they are aware of and follow all directions. As a member of the AUSF travelling team, the following procedures must be followed in relation to COVID management:

Participant has COVID-19 symptoms

1. Notify Team Manager / AUSF staff member / sport leader
2. Temporarily withdraw from current activity
3. Take a rapid antigen test and, where possible, isolate from other participants

Participant tests positive for COVID-19

1. Isolate immediately from other participants and remove yourself from the event venue
2. Notify Team Manager / AUSF staff member / sport leader
3. AUSF will take all reasonable steps to accommodate you at the team hotel
4. Follow WA government directions relating to isolation and notification of test result

Participant is a close contact (as defined by state/territory government) without symptoms

1. Notify Team Manager / AUSF staff member / sport leader
2. Follow WA government directions relating to testing and mask wearing for 5 days (exceptions apply for the purposes of strenuous or vigorous physical activity)
3. Avoid non-essential gatherings for 5 days

Participant is a close contact (as defined by state/territory government) with symptoms

1. Isolate immediately from other participants and remove yourself from the event venue
2. Notify Team Manager / AUSF staff member / sport leader
3. Take a PCR or RAT as soon as possible
4. AUSF will take all reasonable steps to accommodate you at the team hotel in a single room
5. Follow all WA government directions relating to testing and isolation for 5 days

At all times participants must adhere to state/territory directions. Subsequent updates to these directions supersede this agreement. Participants must always remain aware of changes to rules relating to the management of COVID-19 whilst travelling.

Participants must follow all reasonable instructions from AUSF and UniSport Australia staff. This may include mask wearing, hand hygiene, undertaking RATs, and limiting your contact with others. Failure to comply with instructions is a breach of the AUSF Intervarsity Code of Conduct and UniSport Australia Participation Agreement, and may result in sanctions as outlined in these documents.

Any additional costs associated with isolation and travel impacts including accommodation, flight changes, incidentals etc. will not be covered by AUSF. Students should review their travel insurance coverage provided by the University prior to travelling. Travel insurance is not extended to members of the travelling team who are not students, staff or alumni.
